- Any act of cheer or good will counts. We have lots of ideas for you on the Cheer Checklist.
- Every act (each individual card sent, hello said, etc.) counts as a bit of cheer.
- Record your bits of cheer on the Cheer Checklist.



Give cheer.

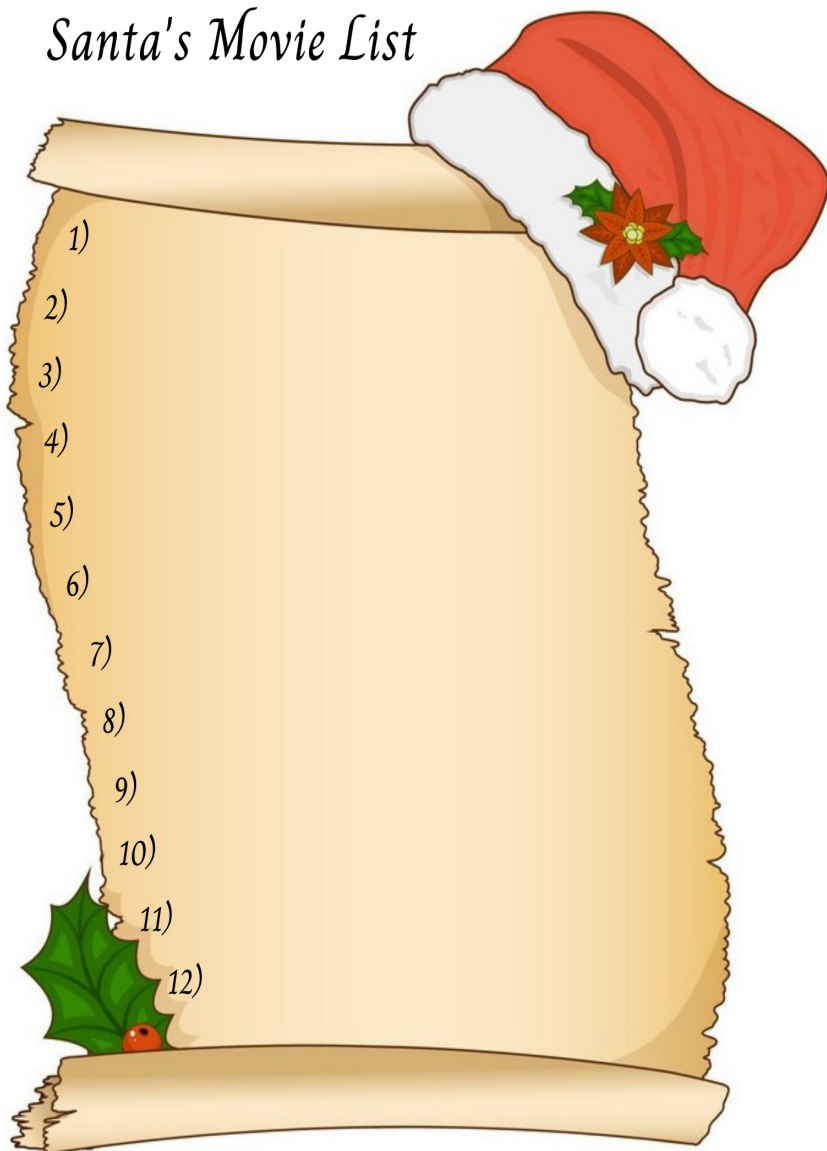
- Report your numbers to the library.

We need all willing elves to start now!

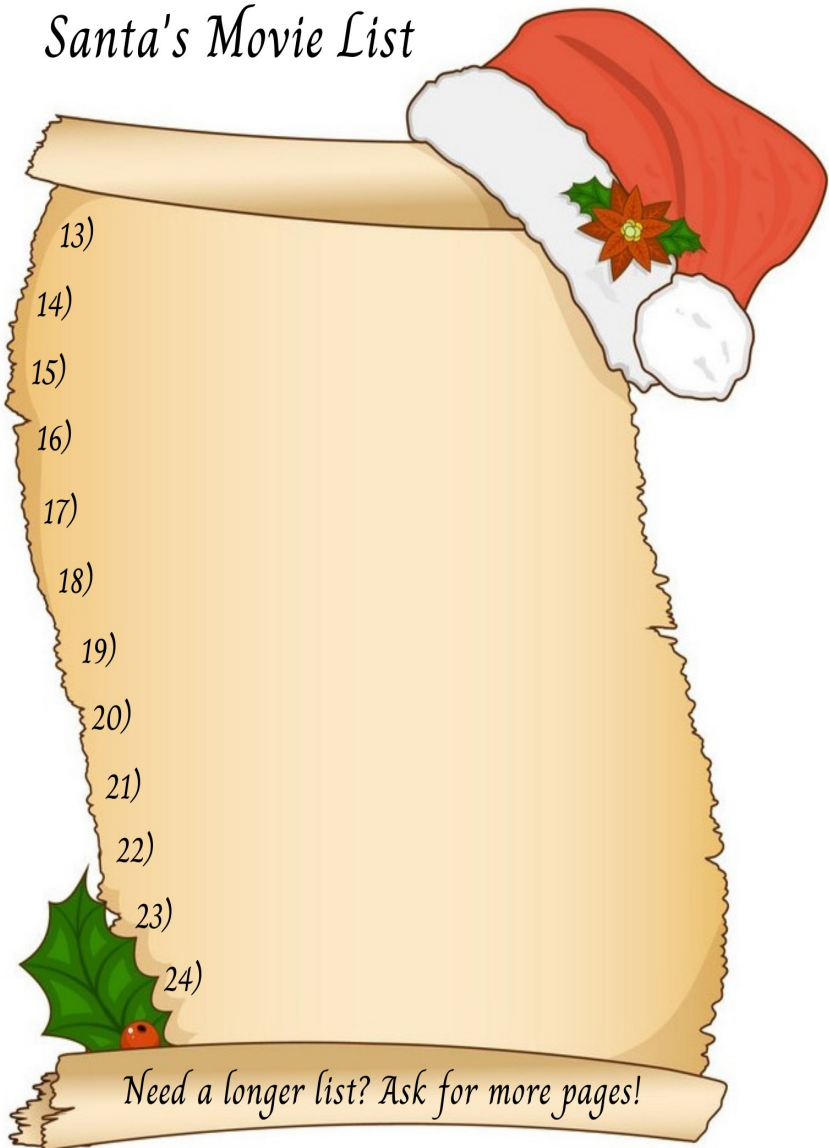
* Give cheer to yourself! You can earn up to \$20 of OOPS credit during this challenge. That's \$20 of library fines you can make disappear!
